INSTRUCTIONS

SURFACE PREPARATION

- Surface temperature should be between 10° C to 35° C.
- Ensure area is well ventilated and surface is dry.
- Mask any surface not intended to be treated.

APPLICATION METHOD

- According to the degree of dirt and substrate condition, liberally apply XC1 undiluted or with cold water in a ratio 1:10 an even coat using a sponge pad, wet mop or cloth. DO NOT USE SPRAYER
- 5-10 minutes after entire application, wipe the entire area with scrubber while rinsing with clean water.
- In case of stubborn stain, use brush or scrubber.
- Remove the water with vacuum cleaner so as to dry out the surface.
- Clean tools with water immediately after application and allow them dry in a well ventilated area.
- Special Instruction Prepare a sample area to examine material consumption and cleaning efficiency.

STORAGE AND HANDLING
